- Inspired by Peter Thiel's experiences with PayPal's fraud detection systems.
- Early funding from the CIA's venture capital arm, In-Q-Tel.
- Expanded from counter-terrorism applications to commercial sectors.
- Listed on NYSE on 30th September 2020.
- Transfer to NASDAQ on 26th November 2024.

- Partnered with Microsoft, IBM, Amazon.



Work for the U.S. Government


- Uncovered China cyber espionage operation GhostNet, which targeted high profile targets, like Dalai Lama or NATO.
