- ▶ Holds a Ph.D. in neoclassical social theory from the University of Frankfurt.
- ▶ Was member of the Board of Directors in BASF.
- ▶ Known for his unconventional approach to leadership.

History of Palantir

- ▶ Inspired by Peter Thiel's experiences with PayPal's fraud detection systems.
- ▶ Early funding from the CIA's venture capital arm, In-Q-Tel.
- ▶ Expanded from counter-terrorism applications to commercial sectors.
- ▶ Listed on NYSE on 30th September 2020.
- ▶ Transfer to NASDAQ on 26th November 2024.

Important Contractors

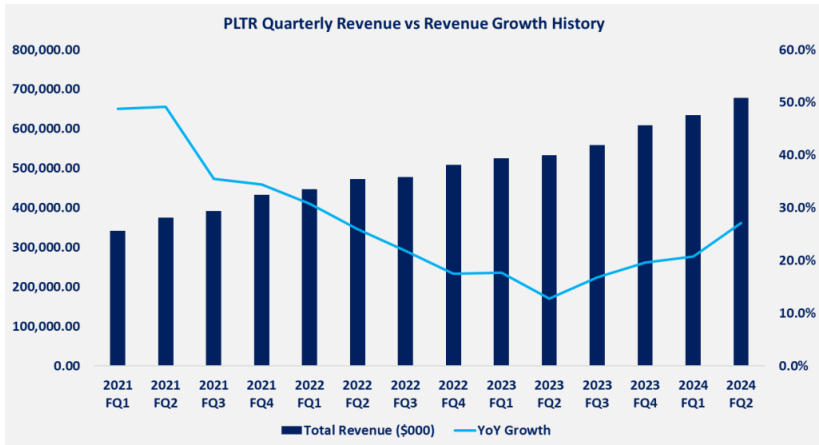
- ▶ U.S. Government: FBI, CIA, and Department of Defense.
- ▶ Commercial clients include Airbus, BP, AT&T and Ferrari.
- ▶ Partnered with Microsoft, IBM, Amazon.

Work for the U.S. Government

- ▶ Uncovered China cyber espionage operation GhostNet, which targeted high profile targets, like Dalai Lama or NATO.
- ▶ Supported the U.S. Army in counter-terrorism operations, such as 'finding bin Laden'.
- ▶ Key player in the COVID-19 response.
- ▶ Backbone of the Ukrainian and Israeli armies.
- ▶ Provides main data handling software in British NHS.

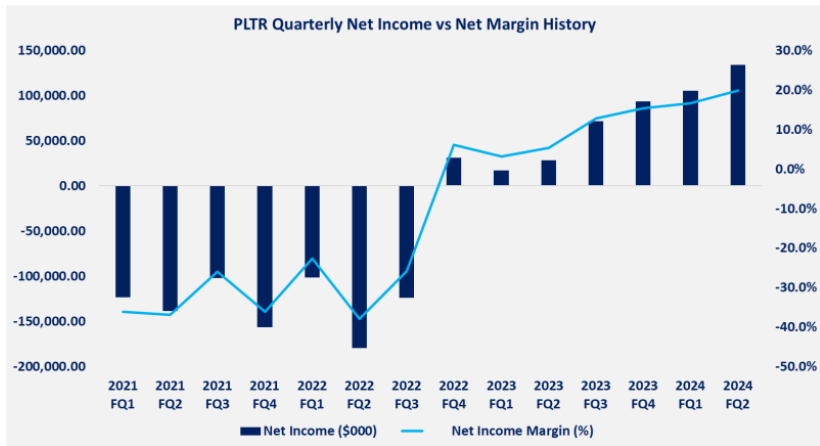
